When the house came down and the land became ours, we celebrated a mountain coming down on Clinton Street.

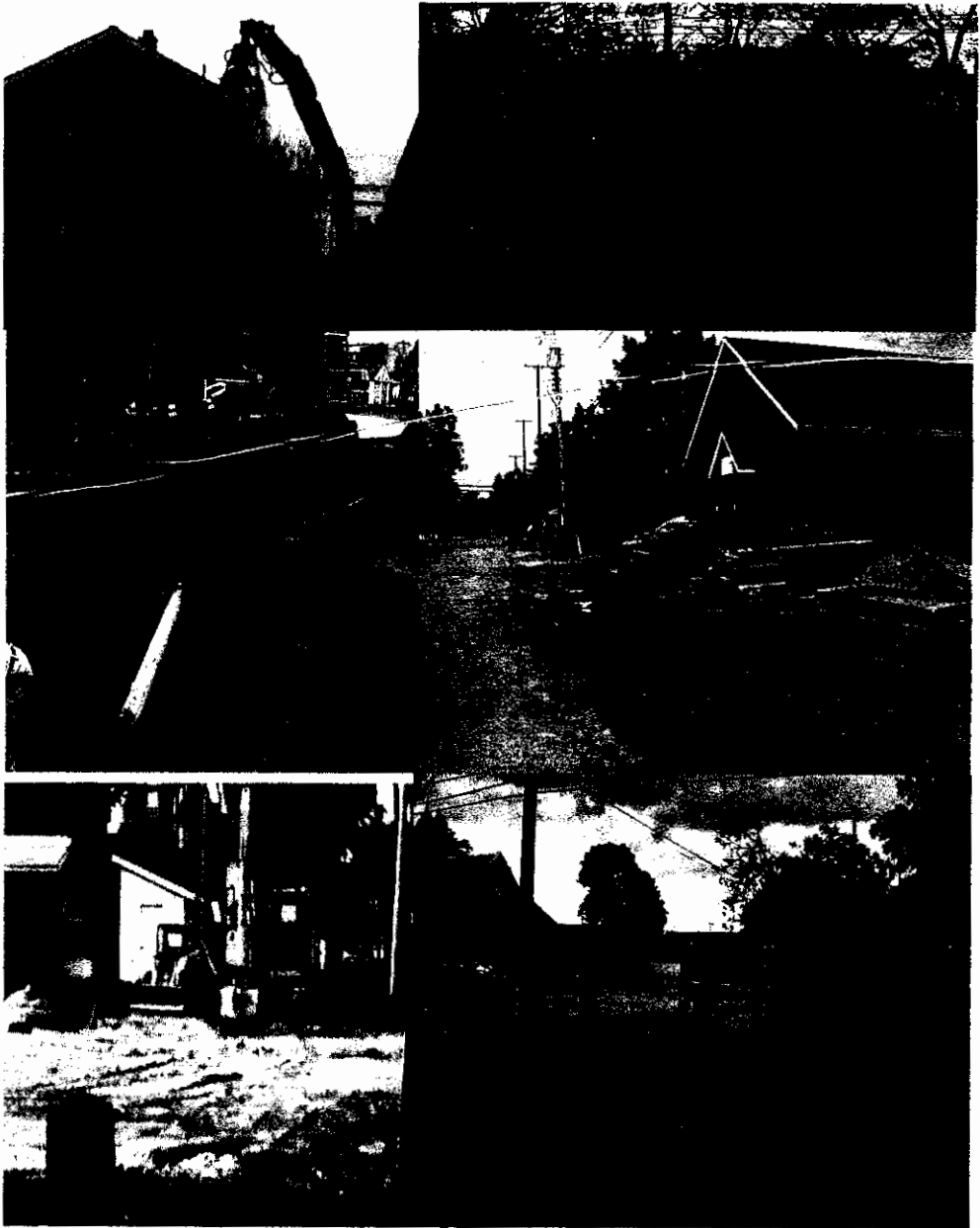
When we voted in May to step forward on this well-designed, faith-filled, and needed endeavor, mountains kept moving on Clinton Street.

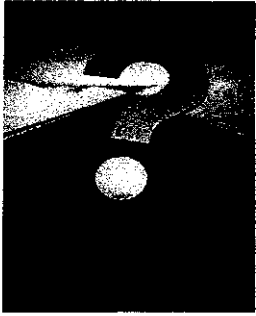
